## **Full-Time Distance Education 2021-2022**

## Information for Parents/Guardians Who Selected Full-Time Distance Education after May 21, 2021

The deadline to opt-in to full-time distance education was May 21, 2021. After reviewing the results of students opting-in to full-time distance education to determine staffing plans, most schools are unable to allocate teachers to provide full-time distance education.

Only the following schools listed below will offer full-time distance education for the 2021-2022 school year:

If your child is assigned to/zoned for one of the schools listed above that will be offering full-time distance education, the school will contact you to determine appropriate placement and class assignment.

If your child is assigned to/zoned for a school that will not be offering full-time distance education and remaining at your assigned/zoned school is important to you, the school is able to change your preference to have your child(ren) attend full-time face-to-face instruction for five days a week. Although it may not be your first preference, schools are excited to have students return for face-to-face instruction.

If you are seeking an independently paced option within full-time distance education, Nevada Learning Academy at CCSD is an online school in the District that does have a full-time distance education program for all students. Nevada Learning Academy at CCSD has an enrollment process that will determine if your student will be a successful online learner. Nevada Learning Academy at CCSD recommends the following commitments:

Three days per week of intermittent, synchronous live sessions with playback sessions available outside of the school day. A learning coach, parent/guardian at the student's side, is required to work with their Grade K-2 student for approximately five hours throughout the day and with their Grade 3-5 student for approximately three hours throughout the day.	Two, one-hour synchronous live sessions per week per course. Playback sessions are available outside the school day.	One, one-hour synchronous live session per week per course. Playback sessions are available outside of the school day.
